

Directions to the Alpine Scout Camp (GNYC)

By Car from New York City: Travel to the George Washington Bridge taking the upper level. Take your first exit on your right in New Jersey (Palisades Pkwy. North). Travel for about 9 miles to exit 2 - Alpine approach road. Follow the exit around under the Pkwy. to a traffic light (this will be Route 9W). Make a right hand turn and travel north for about 1-1/4 miles. Alpine Scout Camp will be on your left hand side.

By Car from New Jersey: From southern or mid-New Jersey, you can take either the New Jersey Turnpike or Garden State Pkwy. to Inter State 80. Travel on 80 to the last exit before the George Washington Bridge toll (this will be in Fort Lee). The exit will say Route 9 and Palisades Pkwy. You may then take either Route 9W for 10 miles to Camp Alpine (it will be on your left), or get on to the Palisades Pkwy. and travel for about 9 miles to exit 2 - Alpine approach road. Follow the exit around under the Pkwy. to a traffic light (this will be Route 9W). Make a right hand turn and travel north for about 1-1/4 miles. Alpine Scout Camp will be on your left hand side.

AT CAMP CONTINUE PAST THE FIRST BUILDINGS AND PARKING LOT, AND FOLLOW THE CAMP ROAD TO REGISTER AT REEVES LODGE.

FROM THE NORTH::

FROM THE TAPPAN ZEE BRIDGE OR UPSTATE NEW YORK:

FROM INTERSTATE 87 OR THE NEW YORK THROUGHWAY, TAKE THE PALISADES INTERSTATE PARKWAY SOUTH TO EXIT 4. GO SOUTH ON ROUTE 9W. ABOUT 1 MILE TO CAMP SIGN ON RIGHT (OPPOSITE PARKWAY ENTRANCE)

FROM THE GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE:

TAKE PALISADES INTERSTATE PARKWAY TO EXIT 2, TURN RIGHT ONTO 9W. GO NORTH ABOUT 1 ¼ MILES TO CAMP SIGN ON YOUR LEFT.

FROM SOUTH FROM THE NJ TURNPIKE:

(Interstate 80, and Interstate 78 will connect with the New Jersey Turnpike. If you have a choice, stay in the LOCAL LANES, not the Express Lanes)

FROM THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE, AFTER PAYING TOLLS, FOLLOW SIGNS TO THE GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE

(STAY IN LOCAL EXIT LANES, DO NOT TAKE EXPRESS LANES)

TAKE EXIT 72 (FOLLOWING SIGNS FOR ROUTES 1, 9W, ETC.)

AT THE TOP OF THE EXIT TURN LEFT AT THE STOPLIGHT. AFTER THE STOPLIGHT WITH THE MOBIL STATION ON YOUR RIGHT, TURN RIGHT ONTO THE PALISADES PARKWAY.

TAKE PALISADES PARKWAY TO EXIT 2 (ALPINE APPROACH ROAD). AT THE LIGHT, TURN RIGHT AND TAKE ROUTE 9W NORTH

ABOUT 1 ¼ MILES TO CAMP SIGN ON LEFT. CAMP IS 9 MILES NORTH OF BRIDGE.

Camp Alpine Directions and Map

Directions From Northern New Jersey Council

- Take Route 4 East to Fort Lee
- Go north on Route 9W to Closter Dock Road, then turn left
- Turn right on Piermont Road and proceed to Ruckman Road
- Turn right on to Ruckman Road and follow it to camp entrance
- Proceed to camp. Camp road-parking lot is on the left

Driving Directions to Alpine Scout Camp

Alpine Scout Camp is located on Route 9W in Alpine, NJ, approximately 9 miles north of the George Washington Bridge.

From New York City, Long Island and Southern Connecticut

From the westbound George Washington Bridge, take the Palisades Parkway North. (It's easier to get to the Palisades Parkway if you take the upper level of the bridge, instead of the lower level.) Get off the Parkway at Exit 2. Stay to the right on the exit ramp and loop around under the Parkway to Route 9W North. Take 9W for about 1.3 miles. The camp entrance will be on your right, just past a foot bridge and opposite a parkway entrance.

From New England

Take the Tappan Zee Bridge westbound to the Palisades Parkway South. Take the Palisades Parkway South to Exit 4. Go South on Route 9W for about 1 mile. The camp sign will be on the right, opposite a parkway entrance.

From South on the New Jersey Turnpike

Follow signs for the George Washington Bridge, but stay in the "Local" lanes - do not take the "Express" lanes. Follow signs to the Palisades Parkway. Take the Palisades Parkway North to Exit 2. Stay to the right on the exit ramp and loop around under the parkway to Route 9W North. Take 9W for about 1.3 miles. The camp entrance will be on your right, just past a foot bridge and opposite a parkway entrance.
